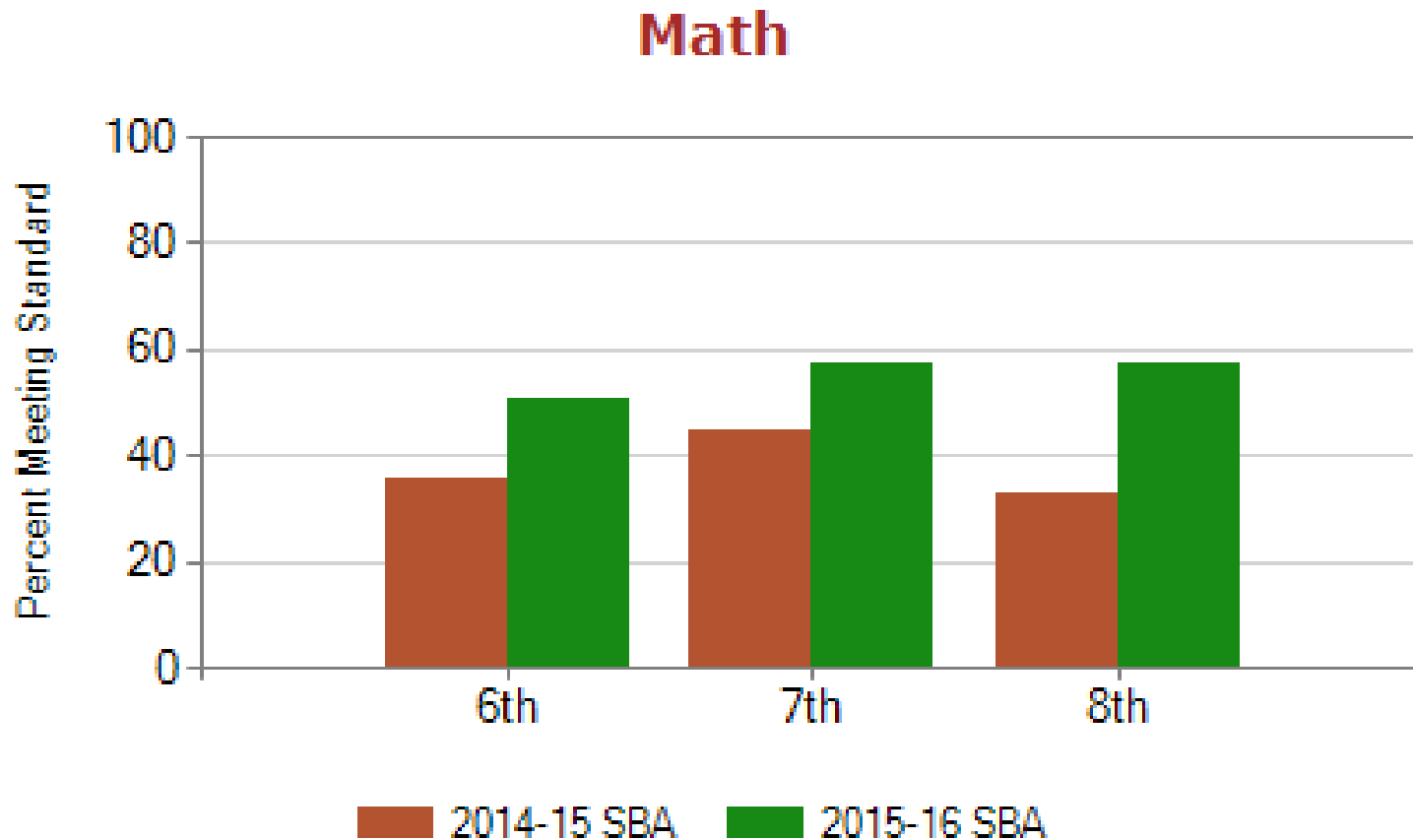

Strategies/Action Plans

- **Math Teachers:**
- Use TDG strategies in instruction
- Re-write math assessments with problem solving questions
- Incorporating AVID rigor and College and Career Readiness strategies
- Beginning of year, teachers chose new engagement strategies they would try from Aug professional development
- Focusing teacher training on engagement and assessment strategies. In goal meetings, teachers shared which strategies they would try or use.

Strategies/Action Plans

- **Principal** and **Assistant Principal**
- Increase classroom walkthroughs
- Informal observations with coaching
- Coaching collaboration groups and leaders.
- Monitor unit tests on grade books and IAB scores state site.
- Support with continued TDG professional development
- Focusing teacher training on engagement and assessment strategies.

Strategies/Action Plans

- **Parent Engagement**
- Provided parent workshops with Dr. Sal Severe, high expectations for parents too!
- Increased parent participation in conferences.
- Social/academic events – Science and Community in Schools.

AVID

- Continue to train teachers in strategies
- Students in AVID empowered
- Instilled College Bound atmosphere
- Students wear college and tech school shirts
- Students more apt to have a plan
- Flex and Rotation classes learn AVID

Success from 2015-2016

- State test – Success! Great scores. Only one school in state with KPMS demographics beat our scores in 4 out of 6 areas. KPMS beat their scores in two areas!
- Student growth in EVERY grade level and BOTH math and Reading/Writing from 2014-15 and 2015-16 school years.
- Only one opt out student for state test.

Measures of Success

- SBA scores
- Results come 1-2 weeks after taking the state exam!
- Students will improve score, stay same if proficient/exceed or move up a level.

Next Steps

- Principal continues to monitor assessments and continue to increase walkthroughs, informal observations, coaching Wed. collaboration groups and provide professional development
- Looking at ways for increased tutoring after taking IAB's
- Continue the implementation of AVID strategies schoolwide and sending teachers to summer institute. (Use Title funds)
- Increase parent and student knowledge of after high school learning opportunities
